

Resample Image and Insert Picture

Image assessment is critical for turning out a *quality* image.

How to Apply Valuable Features or Tools to the Slide Master Format

(Key: > illustrates the path or route on how to apply **Valuable Tools to the Master Slide Layout**)

□ Resample Pictures by using proposed procedural slides:

Image-Editing Software: Explanatory

Image Characteristics: Pixel *Guidelines* I & II (2-slides)

Resolution Options:

□ **On-screen: Web/Screen** – 96^(PC) and 72^(MAC) **dots per inch** (dpi)

□ **Print** – 144 - 192 **dots per inch** (dpi)

Discard extra information by **Cropping** unwanted areas of an image.

Once a Resampled Image, the *Original Image Characteristics* are lost. Some situation an image is saved out twice – two different compressions (three, counting the original image file format):

□ **Web/Screen** □ **Print** □ **Flexible File Format (Tiff)** – Save as

□ **Insert Slide** (*to create a Picture Slide*)

□ **Insert > New Slide**

□ **Insert Picture**

On-screen Display
(View > Slide Show) or **Printout** (File > Print)

□ **Insert > Picture > From File > Insert Picture**
